**World Renowned Grand Master Shi DeCheng**

Qingzhen Chen, whose Dharma name is Shi Decheng, is the founder of Songshan Shaolin Shidecheng Wushu hall. Ever since childhood he has been learning martial arts. In 1980, he furthered his martial arts education with the famous Shaolin boxer Hongbo Jiao, who then recommended him to the great master Shi Suyun of the Shaolin Temple. He is an eighth dan in martial arts, and became the 31st disciple of Shaolin. He continues to participate in martial arts competitions both home and abroad, promoting Shaolin martial arts and Chinese culture. He is well decorated martial artist. His accomplishments have included a gold medal in the International Shaolin Wushu Festival, two gold and one silver in the National Traditional Martial Arts competition, a gold and a silver in the first World Boxing Contest in France, and a gold medal in Paris' seventh and the tenth session of the International Wushu competition, just to name a few.

The French Martial Arts Association awarded the master a (Chen Qingzhen) Gold Trophy, Friendship Award; Italy Wushu Association awarded him the Special Contribution Award Of Martial Arts. He also has visited the United States and other countries like Britain, France, Germany, Switzerland, Austria, Canada, Italy, Southeast Asia, etc. performing and teaching martial arts.

In 2000, CCTV had a special report called “Monk Westbound” for master Decheng. In 2006 the United States television program “Exploration And Discovery” found him and made a special show “Exploring Shaolin Kung Fu”.

Decheng Wushu branches were established In Italy, France, Germany, the United States to communicate Songshan Shaolin martial arts culture. His disciples overseas also have obtained outstanding achievements in competitions at all levels at home and abroad.
